Mulling Meditation - The purpose of mulling meditations is to offer a few

ideas that one can mull about while doing other things. Today's Mediation is:

As you go through this week, mull on what type of presence Jesus offers you in your ordinary life. Notice the times and places where prayer comes easily, notice the times and situations in which you feel the need of grace. In all of those times, places and situations, quietly ask Jesus to be with you.

Mirror Mediation: In the Letter of James, we are told that the Scriptures are like a mirror in which we can see ourselves. In this type of meditation, we take a piece of Scripture, hold it before us and consider what echoes within our heart. These echoes help us to see who we are before God and how we are loved. Mirror Mediation is:

Rest in the love of your God

Recall the significant moments in your life – the times when you saw your life as part of something greater. Amongst those moments, focus on one. Slowly recall what happened, where you were, what was happening, how the moment unfolded. As you recall this moment, ask the Spirit to show you what grace it has for you now. What happened then can enrich you now.
