**You are invited to take this insert home  
for daily reflection:**

Mulling Mediation – The purpose of mulling meditations is to offer a few ideas that one can mull about while doing other things. Today's Mediation is:

**As you go through this week, mull on Jesus' words that one must die in order to live to eternal life. In the large and small events of this week, ask his Spirit to show you how you could lead a richer and deeper life in what you do, say and think.**

Mirror Mediation - In the Letter of James, we are told that the Scriptures are like a mirror in which we can see ourselves. In this type of meditation, we take a piece of Scripture, hold it before us and consider what echoes within our heart. These echoes help us to see who we are before God and how we are loved. Mirror Mediation is:

**Rest in the love of your God.**

**When you are at rest, bring into your mind the suffering that truly disturbs you and tests your faith. It may be your own or that of people you love. Feel the grief, pain and confusion. In the presence of God's love, you can let this arise. Sit with the grief. Now bring that grief to Jesus as he speaks of his hour and the glory that God will reveal through the Cross. Ask him to take that suffering into his own and to give you the wisdom of the Spirit to understand his love in ways that are beyond words.**

**Rest in the love of your God.**
